Your child observations

The end of September beginning of October you will be able to log in to your child learning journey profile and daily diary on a First steps software parent link app. Every parent will be given a log in and password so you can log on and see what your child has eaten, sleeps, nappy changing, observations during the day. This will give you opportunity to ask the staff questions about your child's day, for example if they need wipes, nappies etc and the staff can reply to you during the day. You will be able to comment on your child's observations, photos of daily activities along with adding your own observations from home such as special events, activities during the weekend etc.

This is a way of us communicating with you and you can have that peace of mind during your day.

Pigeon holes

Please can you make sure you are checking every day your child pigeon holes as there will be lots of information being given out to parents about upcoming events, pictures etc.

Dates for the Diary

Staff will be asking you week commencing 16th October to book Keyworker meetings for week com 30th October- we would like every parent to attend a small meeting to discuss your child's next steps as this was a recommendation from our Ofsted inspection. This was because every parent did not attend a keyworker meeting to discuss home learning.

Existing Injuries- please can you ensure you tell the staff if your child has any existing injuries this will save you getting a phone call at work.
