Reminders

If your child is absent from nursery please can you call nursery to inform the manager.

<u>Medication</u>

If your child is on medication please leave yourself enough time to fill out the medication forms at nursery. We are experiencing children requiring inhalers are more and more often now. Once again the medication forms need to be filled out correctly to ensure your child has the correct dosage etc.

Please can we stress to you that you **must not** carry your child up and down the stairs at nursery. It is really important that you adhere to this safety notice.
