

- Can we please ensure your child has a coat when they come to nursery. Also when the weather starts to go cold a hat, scarf and gloves.
- If your child is absent from nursery can we ask you call nursery to inform us of the reasons why.
- We are desperate for girl's leggings or jeans for a spare clothes box if anyone could donate.
